# NGS Navajo Scholarship Information

## Who may apply for an SRP/NGS Navajo Scholarship?

To be eligible, the applicant must be:

- an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation;
- a full-time student at an accredited college or university (minimum 12 credit hours);
- a junior in college during the time the scholarship is used (64 credit hours); and
- Have a minimum overall GPA of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale.

Preference will be given to STEM and business majors.

**What is the value of this scholarship?** Award amounts are determined by the NGS Scholarship Committee. This undergraduate scholarship is renewable with a 3.00 GPA. There is no funding available for graduate students.

**How are the selections made?** The NGS Scholarship Committee reviews all applications. Awards are made based on the field of study, academic excellence, and achievement. Candidates are notified by e-mail. All decisions of the NGS Scholarship Committee are final.

**How are the funds administered?** The NGS Scholarship Committee administers the funds. A check for the full amount of the scholarship award is mailed during the fall semester to the designated educational institution to be credited to the student's account. Scholarships are awarded once a year.

**How does a person apply for an SRP Navajo Generating Station Navajo Scholarship?** Candidates must submit the following documents as the application packet:

\_\_\_ A completed Navajo Generating Station Navajo Scholarship Application.

\_\_\_ A *one-page letter* addressed to the Scholarship Committee explaining career goals, reasons for selecting the field of study, and why the student believes he/she should be selected.

\_\_\_ A current resume, that includes schools attended, employment, community and volunteer activities, school clubs/sports, and awards received.

\_\_\_ Most recent current official transcripts. *Copies or information off the Internet are not acceptable.*

Two letters of recommendation on official letterhead that explore academic achievements, contributions to school or community, and the applicant's character and initiative:

\_\_\_ one letter from an instructor familiar with the applicant's academic abilities; and

\_\_\_ one letter from a college/university advisor or counselor.

\_\_\_ A copy of the applicant's Certificate of Indian Blood to verify enrollment with the Navajo Nation.

**What is the application deadline?** The application period is from **April 1, 2018 – May 31, 2018**. Only complete application packets received by or post marked **May 31, 2018**, will be considered. Send the application packet to:
