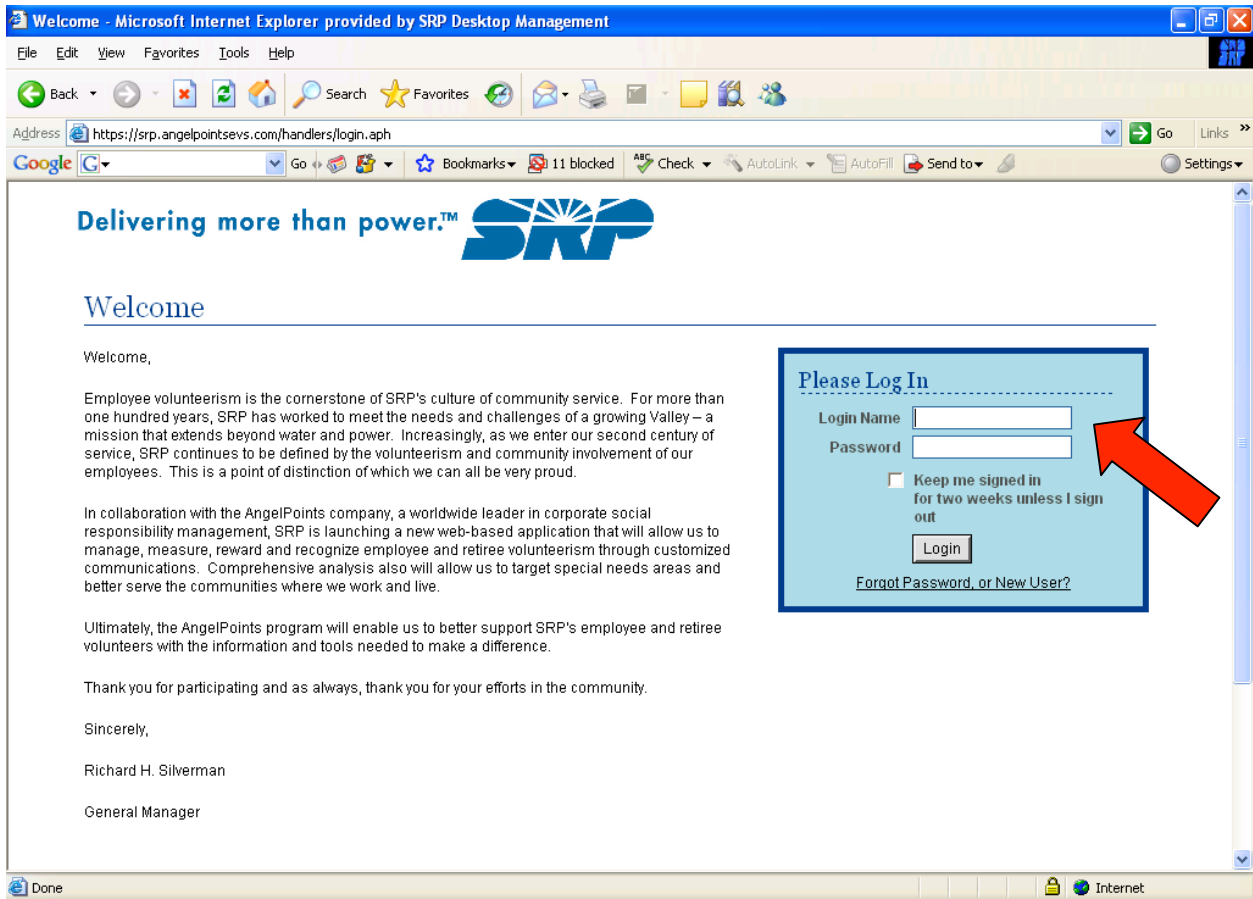


Welcome to AngelPoints! Active participation in the AngelPoints program will allow SRP to track volunteer information in several key areas, including skill sets, level of employee/retiree interest and geographic locations. The system also captures the outcomes of the volunteer events and provides individuals with a means to share their feedback

To get started, go to <http://srp.angelpointsevs.com>.



In the **Login Name** field, enter your payroll number (no letters). The first time you login, use your payroll number again for your **Password**. Later you'll learn how to change your password.

This is the **Home** screen. The first thing you'll want to do is set up your account. Click on the **My Page** tab.

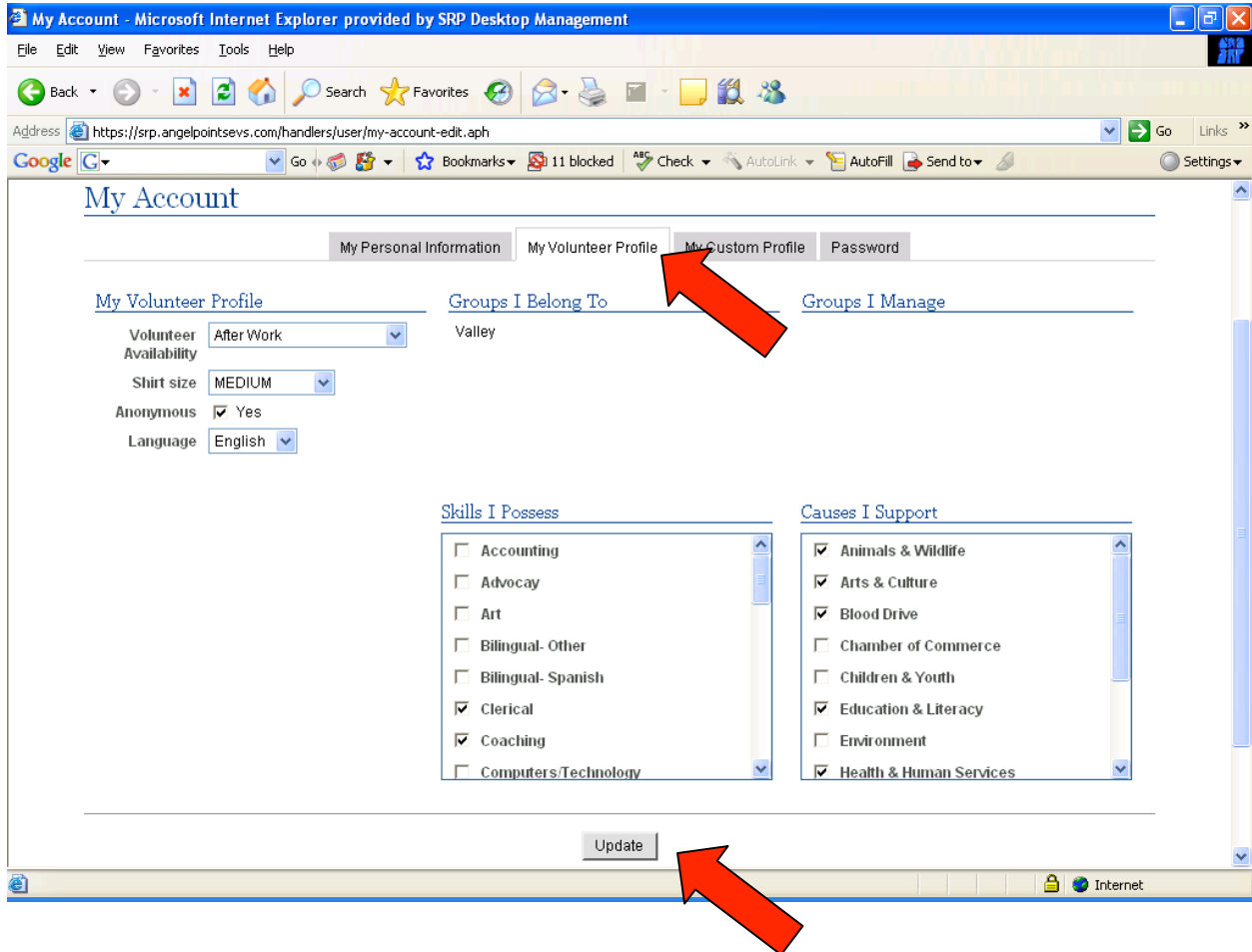

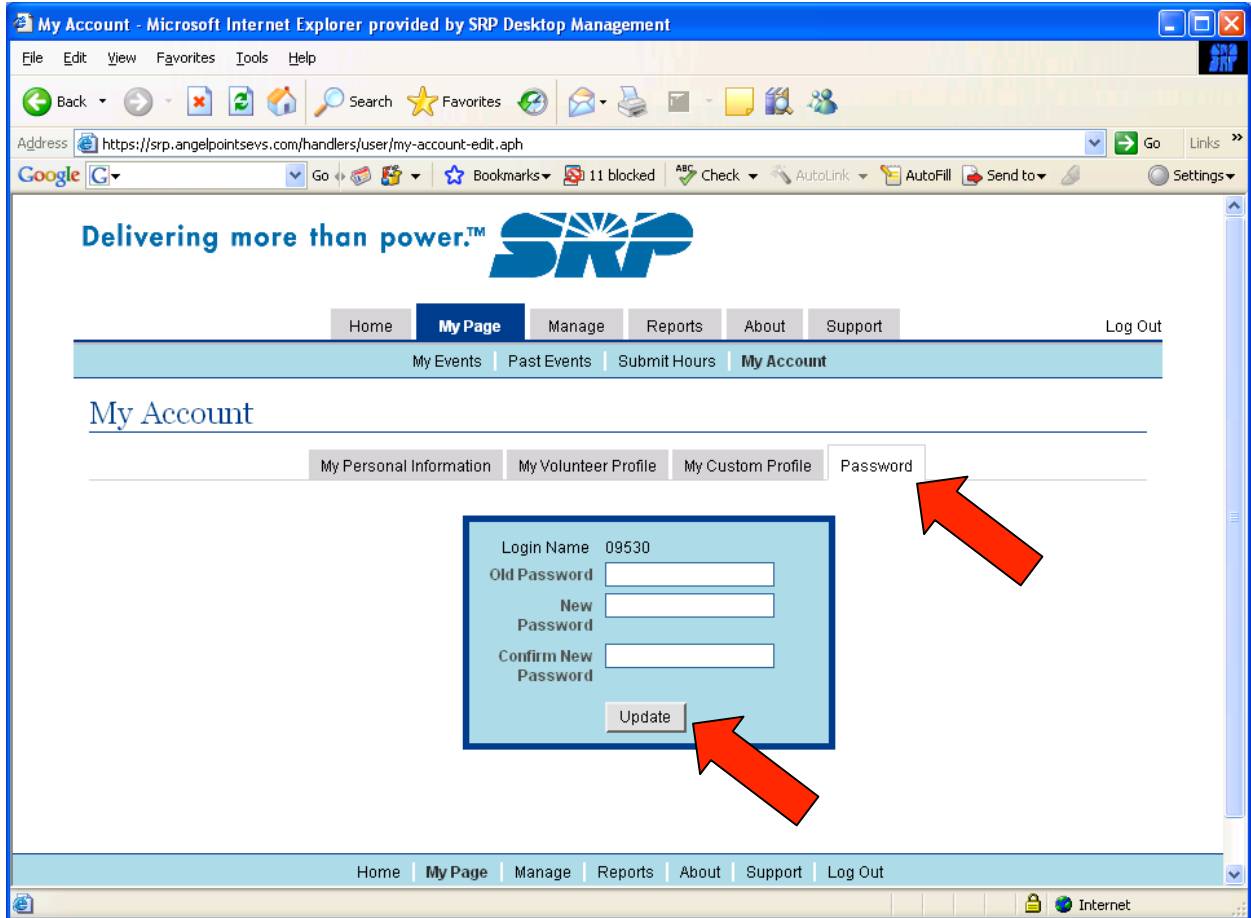

Click on **My Volunteer Profile** next. This section allows you to indicate the skills that you have as well as the causes that you support. We can use this information to better match you with community involvement opportunities. In addition, you can specify your availability as well as let us know what shirt size you need. This will help us maintain our SRP VOLUNTEER shirt inventory. Be sure to click **Update** when you are done.



Now, remember that you used your payroll number to log in for the first time? You'll want to change that password to protect your personal information. To change your password, click on the **Password** tab. You'll be asked to enter your old password, your payroll number, and enter a new password. Be sure to click **Update** when you're done.

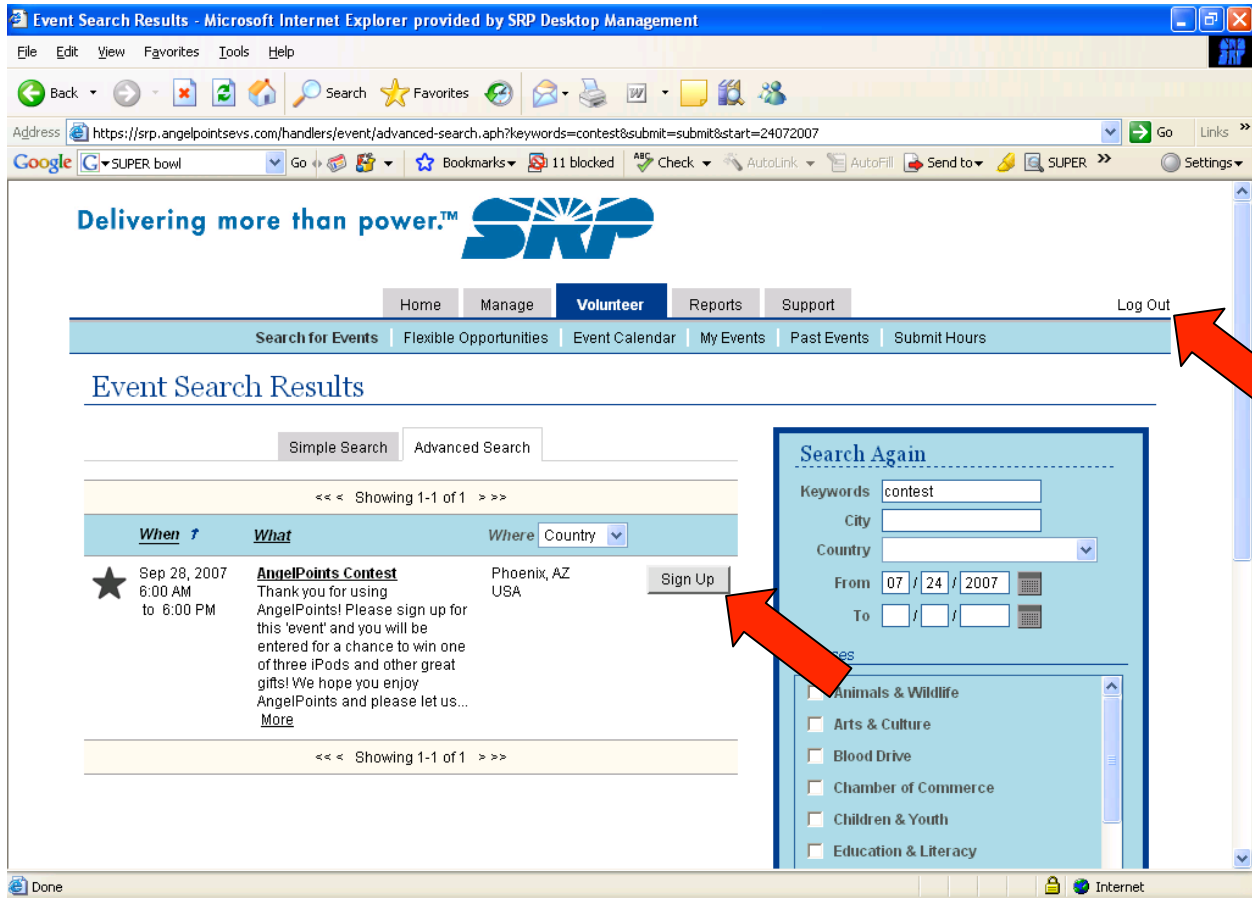

OTHER FEATURES OF ANGELPOINTS

Flexible Opportunities- These are volunteer opportunities that are on-going, community drives or collections for non profit agencies.

Submit Hours- Whether it's an SRP VOLUNTEERS activity or time you spend in your community, you can log your hours. Let AngelPoints look up your agency address or you can enter it into the system.

Advanced Search- You can search for events based on the name of the event, the zip code that the event will take place (to find opportunities close to your home or work), events within a specific date range or opportunities that are support specific causes or skills.

Past Events- This page allows you to see the events that you have participated in as well as the hours that you have logged for those events.
