As I run for re-election to the SRP Council, I am seeking your support to continue advocating for the consistent delivery of SRP power and water at the lowest possible rates.

With 45 years of experience as a general contractor, I've learned the essentials of building a successful business: delivering quality products at the best value and understanding the customers' current and future needs. When I joined the SRP Council 12 years ago, I was pleased to find that SRP's vision and policies for reliable, affordable, and sustainable power and water align perfectly with these principles.
