Anna Mohr-Almeida is a clean air advocate enrolled in the Fulton School of Engineering at Arizona State University. Anna founded Kids Climate Action Network! (Kids CAN!), a 501c3, a youth leadership community working to improve air quality, biodiversity conservation, carbon sequestration, and the creation of purposeful art.

Anna has lobbied locally and in D.C. with Moms Clean Air Force for improved air quality. She was intrinsic to the Rainforest Action Network's Palm Oil Action Leadership Summit and was a member of RAN's National Palm Oil Action Team. This team of palm oil activists work to protect the orangutan, the rainforests in Sumatra and Borneo, and address human rights abuses related to irresponsible palm oil production. Because of their corporate campaign efforts, three multinational companies agreed to responsibly source palm oil used in their products.

Anna was the Youth Keynote at Arizona State University's Local to Global Teach-In and participated on the L2G Youth Keynote Panel and discussed community organizing. Anna has been honored by the Grand Canyon Chapter of Sierra Club as Outstanding Youth. Anna was a member of the Arizona Youth Climate Coalition responsible for climate strikes of 2019-2020. She worked with GenOn, a bipartisan organization dedicated to voter registration and increasing awareness of the impacts of climate change.

Anna sees her candidacy for the SRP Board as her best opportunity to make a substantive impact on reducing greenhouse gas emissions in Arizona. Her vision for water stewardship includes ensuring ephemeral streams and groundwater supplies are available for wildlife and future generations.
