Dave served as CEO of Grand Canyon State Electric Cooperative Association, based in Tempe. GCSECA's membership includes Arizona's rural electric cooperatives, Tribal Utility Authorities and irrigation and electric districts, including SRP. One of GCSECA's key functions is representing and advocating for these consumer-owned utilities at the Arizona Legislature, the Arizona Corporation Commission and the U.S. Congress. Dave also has been city manager of two Colorado communities that own and operate their power and water systems.

Dave has served on and chaired numerous professional and civic boards of directors. He currently is Board Chair of Pioneer Utility Resources, a communications cooperative that provides services to hundreds of utilities across the country.

Dave earned bachelor's degrees in political science and communications from Hastings College and a master's degree in public administration from the University of Colorado. He is married and has two grown daughters and two grandchildren.
