## EARN IT

Some working people with low to moderate income will get hundreds or even thousands back from the IRS when they file and claim the Earned Income Tax Credit. Is there some money waiting for you? Go to [irs.gov/EITC](https://irs.gov/EITC) to see if you qualify.

## KEEP IT

Don't pay to have your taxes prepared. Trained and certified Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) and Tax-Aide preparers will prepare and file your taxes for **FREE!** Get your refund **FAST** if you e-file and use direct deposit.

\*These services are subject to income eligibility.

## SAVE IT

You can save money, reduce your debt and build a better future for yourself and your family. Use Form 8888 to allocate some of your refund to a savings account or to buy savings bonds.

## BEGINNING IN JANUARY

### WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU:

- Social Security cards, IRS ITIN cards or ITIN letters for all household members**
- Picture ID for taxpayer and spouse
- Proof of **ALL** income, including W-2 and 1099 forms
- Statement 1095-A (Health Insurance Marketplace) and/or 1098-T (Tuition)
- Amount paid to child care provider along with their name, address and tax ID
- Account and routing numbers for direct deposit
- Copy of previous year tax return (if available)

If filing jointly, both adults must be present to sign the return.
