

SHADE SCREEN/WINDOW FILM REBATE PROGRAM

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE REBATE APPLICATION FORM

- Complete the Customer Information section of the rebate application (Section A).
- 2. Have your contractor do the following (customer is responsible for the following requirements if DIY):
 - **a.** Complete the Contractor/Installer information in Section B of the rebate application (nonapplicable if DIY).
 - **b.** Specify if releasing rebate (nonapplicable if DIY).
 - **c.** Complete the Shade Screen/Window Film Information portion in Section C of the rebate application.
- 3. Mail the top copy of the completed rebate application and a copy of the dated paid invoice (showing the installation date, installation address, window orientation and square footage) to the following address:

B. IMPORTANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- To qualify for a Shade Screen/Window Film Rebate, the participant must:
 - **a.** Be a permanent SRP residential electric customer and reside in a single-family detached home, a single-family attached home or an apartment/condominium.
 - b. Install new or refurbished shade screens or apply window film that meet program requirements. The rebate application must be submitted within six months of the installation date. For current program requirements, rebate amounts and program effective dates, go to <u>savewithsrp.com</u> or call the Arizona Energy Management Council answer line at (602) 266-7283.
 - c. With the assistance of your contractor or installer (nonapplicable if DIY), submit a completed rebate application and a dated copy of the paid invoice (if installed by a licensed contractor) or purchase invoice (if installed by the customer).
 - **d.** Abide by the rules and rebate levels in effect at the date of installation.
 - e. Allow SRP or its agent to inspect the installed shade screen(s) or window film to verify compliance with all rebate program requirements.
 - f. Have the shade screens or window film installed by a contractor licensed to install shade screens or window film by the Arizona Registrar of Contractors. The customer may choose to install the shade screen or window film material on their own. Please call the Shade Screen/Window Film Rebate answer line at (602) 266-7283 for more information.

- If installation is performed by a licensed contractor, the installing contractor must complete the Contractor/Installer and Shade Screen/Window Film Information sections of the rebate application to qualify for a Shade Screen/Window Film Rebate.
- 3. New or rebuilt, installed solar shade screens must be installed on sunstruck windows only that means east-, west- and south-exposed windows to qualify for the rebate. The material of the solar shade screens must block at least 80% of the solar heat gain. The screens must be installed on the exterior of clear glass windows that enclose an air-conditioned space. Motorized or retractable shade structures are not eligible for the rebate unless installed along with photocell solar sensor equipment.
- 4. Qualifying window film must be installed on sunstruck windows only west-, south- and east-facing windows. Window film can have up to a maximum solar heat gain coefficient of .45% on double-pane windows and .40% on single-pane windows. Window film must be installed on windows that enclose an air-conditioned space. Eligible window film must be certified by the National Fenestration Rating Council (NFRC).
- **5.** Failure to provide any of the required information, including signatures, will result in the return of the rebate application.
- **6.** Program procedures, requirements and rebate levels are subject to change or cancellation without notice.
- 7. One rebate check will be issued per approved application to the person listed as the customer of record on the SRP account.
- 8. SRP makes no representations and provides no warranty or guarantee with respect to the design, manufacture, construction, safety, performance or effectiveness of the shade screens or window film, including any warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. The contractor selected by the customer is solely responsible for the proper installation of the shade screens or the window film as well as the delivery and workmanship related to any equipment or services the customer procures. The customer is responsible for the selection and supervision of the contractor to ensure that the contractor complies with the requirements of the SRP Shade Screen/Window Film Rebate Program. SRP assumes no responsibility for the quality or oversight of contractor services.
- 9. The Terms and Conditions set forth herein constitute a complete statement of the Terms and Conditions applicable to this promotion and supersede all prior representations or understandings, whether written or oral. SRP shall not be bound by or liable for any statement, representation, promise, inducement or understanding of any kind that is not set forth herein. SRP reserves the right to change or cancel this promotion or its Terms and Conditions at any time.
