Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at Mesa Convention Center, 263 North Center Street, Mesa, Arizona 85201, commencing on Thursday, September 6, 2018 at 1:00 p.m., and will continue on Friday, September 7, 2018, beginning at 9:30 a.m. The hearing will recess until Monday, September 10, 2018 beginning at 10:00 a.m. and will continue each weekday on September 11, 2018 through September 14, 2018, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:30 a.m. each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on Tuesday, September 11, 2018, at approximately 9:00 a.m. or an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee ("Chairman"). Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on Thursday, September 6, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day

1 or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later 2 ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day. Additional days for the hearing may be set, and the hearing may conclude earlier 3 4 or later than anticipated, depending upon the number of parties that intervene, the 5 amount of testimony presented, the amount of public comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public meeting/hearing, members of 6 the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and, at the discretion of the 7 Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed power plants and transmission lines for 8 9 the project as set forth above. 10 At the public meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate and/or vote on the matters on the agenda. Items on the agenda may be taken in a 11 different order than listed as conditions require: 12 13 14 1. Call to order; 15 2. Roll call; 16 17 18 3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene; 19 4. Hearing on the application; 20 21 22 5. Public comment at the discretion of the Chairman; 23 6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route; 24 25 ///

- 7. If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will meet at the hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members of the public may follow the Committee's tour. No testimony or discussion with or between Committee members about the application or matters relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;
- Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of environmental compatibility;
- Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of environmental compatibility;
